Racial Reconciliation: The Church's Great Unfinished Work



The Rev. Dr. Allan Boesak (born 1945) was a leading anti-apartheid activist for decades. He was the driving force behind the United Democratic Front, and later the African National Congress (ANC), which led the way to democracy in South Africa and the election of Nelson Mandela in 1994. He served as a pastor in Paarl (1967-70), then studied in Holland and New York, earning his PhD in 1975. He led a parish in Cape Town from 1976 until his unanimous election as president of the 70 million member World Alliance of Reformed Churches (WARC) in 1982, where he introduced a heresy motion that led to the suspension of South Africa's unrepentant and racist Dutch Reformed Churches from WARC. He is the author of many books and continues to advance the ideas of liberation, justice and wholeness for all God's people.

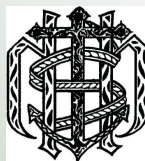

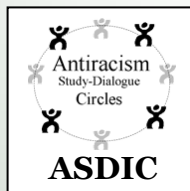
