Darrell Guder is Princeton Theological Seminary's Dean of Academic Affairs and the Luce Professor of Missional & Ecumenical Theology. His Ph.D. is from the University of Hamburg. As an ordained Presbyterian minister, he served as pastor/faculty member of the Karlsruhe College in the German Lutheran Church. His writing and teaching focus on the theology of the missional church, especially the theological implications of the paradigm shift to post-Christendom as the context for Christian mission in the West. He currently serves as vice president of the American Society of Missiology, and is the author of *The Continuing Conversion of the Church* and *Missional Church*.
